

### Introduction

The 4th wave of COVID-19 in Canada has begun and it is apparent in the increase of cases associated with the Delta variant. We will be closely monitoring regions and would like to inform members to be prepared for potential additional Areas of Risk if the numbers continue to increase over the next weeks.

This week, 5 new Areas of Risk are identified in the Travel section. Members must prepare to isolate upon return from these areas if arriving after Friday, August 20<sup>th</sup> 20 at 11:59PM.

Our communities remain the safest place allowing for larger gatherings due to the commitment of community residents and hard work of public safety teams. Please continue to follow protocols such as hand washing, social distancing and wearing a face covering properly.

- Mistissini 4 – Related to Travel outside Eeyou Istchee and isolating outside Eeyou Istchee

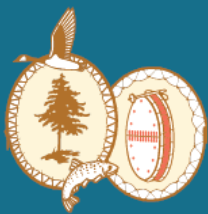

### Travel

Effective Friday, August 20<sup>th</sup> at 11:59pm, 2021, travel to an Area of Risk will require self-isolation:

- Fully vaccinated – 7 days with a test on Day 5
- Partially vaccinated or unvaccinated – 10 days with a test between day 5-7

[Areas of Risk : 04 - Mauricie et Centre-du-Québec; 06 – Montréal; 13 - Laval; 14 – Lanaudière; 15 – Laurentides; 16 – Montérégie]

### PROOF OF VACCINATION (Vaccine Passport):

September 1<sup>st</sup>, 2021 proof of vaccination/vaccine passport will be required for modes of travel and to access certain public areas in Quebec. To obtain your proof of vaccination please consult the site and form below:
